

## The inaugural Derwent Dambuster Challenge

The **Derwent Dambuster Challenge** is a prestigious new 10 mile event around the beautiful Upper Derwent Valley which aims to raise money for Challenge Cancer Through Adventure.

The event takes place on **Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2006**, starting at 9am near Fairholmes visitor centre. Places are limited to 50 runners (18s and over only) and the closing date for entries is 5<sup>th</sup> May 2006. Entrance fee is £10, with a minimum sponsorship of £50 to be raised. There will be spot prizes, a prize for the highest sponsorship and certificates and T-shirts for all finishers.

The route is mainly flat, with a few short gentle slopes. The first part of the course is on rough surfaced tracks and the second part is on a tarmac road. The route will be marshalled and signed throughout.

**Challenge Cancer Through Adventure** was established by 7 Peak District based adventure enthusiasts, together with their families and friends. All seven either have or have had cancer. They wanted to enable other people with cancer or a terminal illness to 'live a dream' and to challenge people's perceptions of cancer and terminal illness.

**Challenge Cancer Through Adventure** aims to support adventurous activities for anyone diagnosed with cancer or a terminal illness living in or around the Peak District. For some, **Challenge Cancer** may provide support for their first adventure experience, for example an abseil or a parachute jump or for others it might support one more great adventure.
